

# Polarized Response

Luke 2:22-52 - Sunday, February 2, 2020

## Probing the Passage

### Poor:

- In Leviticus 12, the ritual for purification after childbirth is given.
- The time of purification is 33 days.
- Relevantly, the initial command is to give a year old lamb for a burnt offering and a young pigeon or dove for a sin offering.
- A provision is made if the woman cannot \_\_\_\_\_ a lamb.

### Presented and Dedicated:

- Jesus is \_\_\_\_\_ to God as an infant.
- This was a common thing, set forth in Exodus 13:2.
- And yet, Jesus is the one who stays dedicated.
- He is given to the Father, to have the foremost concerns before him be the Father's and he, unlike all before him, remains there.

### Simeon:

- We come upon someone else who is righteous (like Zechariah and Elizabeth).
- We come upon someone else who is filled with the Holy Spirit.
- This person is called to explicitly see the Lord's Messiah.
- The Messiah is the \_\_\_\_\_ event of Simeon's Life.
  - ◇ Simeon mirrors Moses in this way.

### The Promised Messiah:

- Simeon was supposed to see the promised inheritance of God.
- His witness is testified to, or through, the Holy Spirit.
- He immediately declares that Jesus is it.

### For All:

- Both the Gentiles and Israel.
  - ◇ Gentiles is first in this formulation.
- Jewish Man at the Jewish Temple meets a Jewish Family and proclaims light for the \_\_\_\_\_!

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**Falling and Rising:**

- The “Falling and Rising of many in Israel” is initially shocking.
  - ◊ What do you mean \_\_\_\_\_?
- A rising tide lifts all boats! I thought Jesus is a rising tide...
- What happens if a boat is moored too tightly?

**Of Many....**

- We believe that God’s Elect are all around us, that includes:
  - ◊ Democrats
  - ◊ Republicans
  - ◊ Soldiers
  - ◊ Pacifists
  - ◊ Straight-identifying
  - ◊ LGBTQ+identifying
  - ◊ Weed-smoking
  - ◊ Teetotalers

**An Opposed Sign:**

- This Child is to be a sign that is opposed.
- The Savior’s life is not without opposition.
- God’s Holy Chosen Son, come to redeem Israel and bring light to the gentiles, faces opposition.
- How much more those who follow him?

**Reveals Inner Thoughts:**

- What you think of Jesus reflects as much about you as about him.
- The Jesus we encounter will demand a \_\_\_\_\_.

**Demands:**

- The Jesus we will meet demands \_\_\_\_\_ from us.
  - ◊ Our time
  - ◊ Our Good Will
  - ◊ Our loves and affections
  - ◊ Our Heart, Soul and Strength
  - ◊ All that we are.

**In Exchange:**

- Join the Never-ending kingdom. (1:33)
- He shows mercy to all who fear him. (1:50)
- He lifts the lowly. (1:52)

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- He fills the Hungry. (1:53)
- He saves us from our enemies. (1:71)
- He brings salvation through forgiveness of their sins. (1:77)
- He gives light to those who sit in darkness. (1:79)

**Anna:**

- She is this fantastic woman of God.
- She has been widowed since she was in her twenties.
- For the last 60 years, she has \_\_\_\_\_ herself to the Lord.
- Not for show, not for respect, but just to get close to him.

**Meeting Him:**

- When this woman meets Jesus, she can't shut up about him.
- Anyone she knows with even vague interest is grabbed.
- Might we be like Anna.
- Might we proclaim the Lord's works every moment as we encounter our Risen Lord!

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
