I've had some memorable birthdays. When I was about twelve we marked the day with a helicopter sight-seeing flight over Los Angeles, a trip earned by diligently pursuing new subscriptions for my paper route. I'm not sure if I enjoyed more the views of the landscape from the sky or the white-faced expression of petrified fear on my mother's face as she accompanied me on the trip. There were a couple of Disneyland visits along the way as well. Those were the days when admission and a fifteen ride ticket book cost less than the price of parking today. My sixteenth birthday celebration included a trip to the DMV for my first driver license, a symbolic ticket to independence valued by most teens. The National Day of Prayer was created in 1952 by a joint resolution of Congress, and signed into law by President Harry S. Truman. In 1988, the law was unanimously amended by both the House and the Senate and signed into law by President Ronald Reagan on Thursday, May 5, 1988, designating the first Thursday of May as a day of national prayer. Every president since 1952 has signed a National Day of Prayer proclamation.

Prayer brings people together. Prayer builds bridges between opposing persons and even political parties. Prayer reminds us that we are created in God's image and He desires for us to represent Him everywhere we go. Prayer brings UNITY. In 2018, our theme will be **Pray for America - UNITY**, based upon Ephesians 4:3 which challenges us to mobilize unified public prayer for America, "Making every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace."




